**Methods** Outcomes of 12 hackathons from 2012 to 2015 in India, Uganda and the USA were measured using emailed surveys.

# Health hackathons: theatre or substance? A survey assessment of outcomes from healthcare-focused hackathons in three countries

30% continued work beyond hackathon

12% Clinical Studies with healthcare provider

27% initiating business plan

70% project initiated through hackathon

85% increased confidence in initiating medical venture
